d. Commercial Purposes.

Commercial purposes, if any, included in the Articles are intended only to advance or support one or more of the non-profit purposes of the Corporation. No part of the Corporation's profits or of its property or accretions to the value of the property may be distributed, directly or indirectly, to a member, a director or an officer of the Corporation except in furtherance of its activities or as otherwise permitted by the Act.

e. Transferring Membership.

A Membership in the Corporation is not transferable and automatically terminates if the Member resigns, dies or such Membership is otherwise terminated in accordance with the Act or the Corporations By-laws.

f. The Charities Accounting Act

The Corporation shall be subject to the Charities Accounting Act.

g. Director Remuneration

No director shall receive remuneration for services provided in the capacity as a director, although they may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties. Unless otherwise prohibited by the Corporation, a director may be compensated for services other than as a director pursuant to the regulation made under the Charities Accounting Act, or with court approval or an order made under section 13 of the Charities Accounting Act.

h. Investing Funds

The Corporation shall invest the funds of the Corporation pursuant to the Trustee Act.
